Achieving this goal is essential for sustainable development, as it fosters social stability, upholds human rights, and ensures transparency in governance. SDG 16 addresses critical issues such as reducing violence, eliminating corruption, and enhancing participatory decision-making. By supporting the development of effective institutions and legal frameworks, we can work towards a just society where everyone has the opportunity to thrive. This presentation explores key aspects of SDG 16 and the initiatives being taken to advance peace, justice, and strong institutions.



Mobile court



In order to strengthen students' legal literacy, legal knowledge and skills, on November 15, 2023, at the University of World Economy and Diplomacy, the chairman of the Mirzo Ulugbek District Court for Criminal Cases Sh. Bakayev, judges M. Kayumov, S. Abdug'aniyev, a mobile court session was organized with the participation of M. Kukiyev.

At the meeting, the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PF-158 of September 11, 2023 on the strategy "Uzbekistan - 2030", as well as amendments and additions to the Criminal Procedure Code of the Republic of Uzbekistan Students of the Faculty of International Law were closely introduced to the content and essence of supplements, the practice of applying international norms to procedural legislation. In addition to legal skills, mobile court cases help students improve their analytical skills. The objectives of the mobile court session were successfully achieved.

At the meeting, students received answers to their questions about prevention of crime among young people, in particular, theft, violation of traffic rules and cyber crimes and measures to protect against them.

On February 22, 2023, a mobile court session was held at JIDU under the chairmanship of Mirzo Ulugbek district court judges S. Abduganiyev and M. Kukiyev.

Vice-rector of the university O. Yusufjanov, deputy dean of the Faculty of International Relations S. Ibadullayev and students of the second stage of the Faculty of International Law took part in the court process.




On August 16–17, 2023, the Representative of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan on Children's Rights (Ombudsman) and the Legal Clinic of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy, on the basis of the Memorandum on joint activities and "Monitoring closed institutions in order to ensure access to justice for minors" within the framework of the project, he carried out monitoring of the investigative detention center of the Ministry of Internal Affairs in Zangiota district.

The project "Monitoring closed institutions for minors in order to ensure their access to justice" is aimed at protecting children's rights and ensuring equal opportunities for them in the judicial process. The monitoring results are used in seminars at the Legal Clinic and in the further development of recommendations and proposals for the effective implementation of international standards into national legislation.



A simulation of the economic litigation process for the protection of intellectual property rights was conducted.





On March 6, 2023, at the Legal Clinic of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy, in cooperation with the Tashkent State Law University, a simulation of the economic trial on the protection of intellectual property rights was held.

Rakhimov A.Sh., chief adviser of the Department of Legal Protection of Intellectual Property of the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Uzbekistan, as a judge. took In the modeling process, 2nd–3rd year students of JISU participated as claimants, and students of TDYU participated as respondents.


At the end of the trial, Rakhimov A.Sh., who conducted the trial as a judge. interpreted the speeches of both parties and gave them practical advice and valuable guidance on the protection of intellectual property rights. He also emphasized the prospects and relevance of this area of law.

Based on this resolution, the commission conducted its activities from 2022 to 2024. Professor Gulnoza Saydiganikhodjayevna Ismailova, Vice-Rector for Research and Innovation of the University of World Economy and Diplomacy, served as a member of the information-analytical working group within this commission.

Mamlakatimizni rivojlantirishning beshta ustuvor yoʻnalishi boʻyicha Harakatlar strategiyasi doirasida oʻtgan davr mobaynida davlat va jamiyat hayotining barcha sohalari tubdan isloh qilindi.

Jamiyat va davlat qurilishi tizimini takomillashtirish, qonun ustuvorligini va inson huquqlarini ta'minlash, iqtisodiyotni liberallashtirish, ijtimoiy sohani rivojlantirish, aholi turmush darajasini yaxshilash, davlat organlarining hisobdorligi va ochiqligini kuchaytirish hamda fuqarolik jamiyati institutlarining rolini oshirish boʻyicha tizimli ishlar amalga oshirildi.

Mazkur islohotlar natijasida mamlakatimizda Yangi Oʻzbekistonni barpo etishning zarur siyosiy-huquqiy, ijtimoiy-iqtisodiy va ilmiy-ma'rifiy asoslari yaratildi.

Oʻzbekiston taraqqiyotining yangi bosqichida mamlakatimizda olib borilayotgan islohotlar natijadorligini oshirish koʻp jihatdan yangilanishlarning konstitutsiyaviy asoslarini mustahkamlash, jamiyat va davlat boshqaruvi sohasidagi faoliyatni tubdan takomillashtirishni taqozo etadi.

Oʻtgan yili boʻlib oʻtgan Oʻzbekiston Respublikasi Prezidenti saylovi jarayonida keng jamoatchilik tomonidan Bosh qomusimizga oʻzgartirishlar kiritish, uni bugungi kun talablari darajasiga olib chiqish borasida koʻplab takliflar ilgari surilgan edi. Bular xalqimizning mamlakatda boʻlayotgan keng koʻlamli oʻzgarishlarga befarq emasligini, islohotlarning faol ishtirokchisi boʻlishga intilayotganligini yaqqol koʻrsatdi.

Ushbu takliflar Oʻzbekiston Respublikasi Prezidenti Sh.M. Mirziyoyevning lavozimiga kirishish marosimidagi nutqi va Oʻzbekiston Respublikasi Konstitutsiyasi qabul qilinganining 29 yilligiga bagʻishlangan bayram tabrigida ham oʻz aksini topgan edi.

Bosh qomusimizda "inson — jamiyat — davlat", "Yangi O'zbekiston — ijtimoiy davlat" tamoyillarini mustahkamlash, iqtisodiy islohotlar jarayonida inson manfaatlarini ta'minlash bosh mezon bo'lishini ta'minlash, xususiy mulk daxlsizligini, yerga egalik qilish huquqini, fuqarolik jamiyati institutlarining o'rnini konstitutsiyaviy darajaga ko'tarish kabi masalalar tobora dolzarb ahamiyat kasb etmoqda.

Yangi Oʻzbekistonning taraqqiyot strategiyasida belgilangan keng koʻlamli vazifalar, xalqparvar davlatni barpo etish, inson huquq va manfaatlari, qadr-qimmatini yanada samarali ta'minlash kabi maqsadlar mamlakatimizdagi tub islohotlarga mos yangi konstitutsiyaviy-huquqiy makonni yaratish zaruratini yuzaga keltirmoqda.


<u>UWED MODEL UN</u>
